### Chrissy Abrahms Woodland

Chrissy Abrahms Woodland currently serves as the Director for the Division of Metropolitan HIV/AIDS Programs (DMHAP) within the Health Resources and Services Administration's (HRSA) HIV/AIDS Bureau (HAB). DMHAP administers Part A of the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program as well as the Ending the HIV Epidemic: A Plan for America (EHE) initiative for the 39 funded EHE Part A jurisdictions.
