Ending the HIV Epidemic

- **2.7 million** HIV tests conducted in 2019
- **More than 196,000 patients** with HIV received primary care services at health centers, including many sites co-funded by the Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program
- **More than 600** health centers purchase Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis (PrEP) through the 340B Program
- FY 2020: **\$54 million** to support **195 health centers** increase outreach, testing, care coordination, and HIV prevention services, including PrEP, in targeted counties/cities and states.
- FY 2021 President's Budget Request: **\$137 million** to support the second year of the Ending the HIV Epidemic Initiative - increasing participation to over 500 health centers in the Initiative's targeted geographic regions.

PCHP Progress Report Updates

Of the 195 health centers that received \$54 million in Primary Care HIV Prevention (PCHP) funding, within the first 5 months of award:

- 65% of HCs have been able to hire new staff;
- 246,392 patients tested for HIV;
- 1,512 patients were newly diagnosed with HIV and received follow-up within 30 days; and
- 19,127 patients were prescribed PrEP



Health Centers Response to COVID-19

As of October 23, 2020, health centers have provided **4.9 million** COVID-19 tests, including over **278,000** antibody detection tests.

- **Over 553,000** health center patients have tested positive for COVID-19, with **59%** being racial/ethnic minorities
- **Over 16,420** health center staff have tested positive for COVID-19

In the latest weekly survey:

- **81%** of health centers reported having viral COVID-19 walk-up or drive-up testing capacity
- **26%** of visits were conducted virtually
- Health centers visits were at **84%** of their pre-COVID volume

- Held a webinar on *Using Technology to Advance Prescribing Practices for PrEP* to support health centers' implementation and use of telehealth to improve access to care for PLWH and PrEP prescribing practices.
- Provided resources on HIV Self-Testing and efforts to support HIV prevention practices during the COVID-19 pandemic.
